# **OTHER REQUIREMENTS:**

Pre-Orientation Reading/Assignments: early May – June 4, 2025

Reading/Assignments: June 7, 2025 – June 6, 2026

Each month begins with a Bible study on that month's theme. Supplementary reading will average 250 pages per month give or take. You will write a one-to-three-page Response Paper to give to your Mentor, summarizing your response to each month's reading. In July and August, you will write two additional papers, "The Texture of my World" and "My Spiritual Autobiography", to give your Mentor at the Retreat. Audio and video resources will also be assigned each month, as well as several online personal inventories.

# COST:

This covers the cost of your participation in the fall weekend retreat and an service project day ("Who is My Neighbor?"). Fellows must also pay for the books and materials required for the program.
